Dr. Eugene R. Viscusi is Director of Acute Pain Management and Regional Anesthesia in the Department of Anesthesiology, Thomas Jefferson University in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and Associate Professor of Anesthesiology. After receiving a medical degree from Jefferson Medical College, Dr. Viscusi completed a residency in anesthesiology at the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia. His research interests include the development of new pain management techniques, outcome studies with pain management, and the development of novel agents and delivery systems for pain management. He developed a novel “nurse driven” model for delivering acute pain management with specially trained nurses that has served as a model for other institutions. Dr. Viscusi also has been a primary investigator for many emerging technologies in the perioperative arena.

Dr. Viscusi is a member of numerous professional associations including the American Society of Anesthesiologists, The American Society of Regional Anesthesiology, The International Anesthesia Research Society and serves on numerous society committees. Dr. Viscusi has lectured extensively both nationally and internationally, has authored more than 100 book chapters, abstracts and has authored over 50 peer-reviewed articles in journals including *Journal of the American Medical Association*, *Anesthesiology*, *Anesthesia & Analgesia*, and *Regional Anesthesia and Pain Medicine*. Dr. Viscusi currently serves on the editorial board of *The Clinical Journal of Pain* and regularly reviews for many journals. He also has appeared in articles in major media including *Newsweek*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *USA Today* and has appeared nationally on televised interviews.
